

COURSE OVERVIEW

The Occupational Certificate: Store Person (Level 2) is structured to provide learners with the essential competencies required to perform effectively in wholesale, retail, and distribution environments. This qualification emphasises practical skills in stock movement, packing, picking, and storage maintenance, with a strong focus on minimising losses and upholding safety standards.

Upon successful completion, learners will be equipped to manage stock efficiently, thereby enhancing operational productivity and contributing to the overall profitability of the organisation.

- Accurately pick and count stock within designated storage areas.
